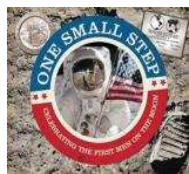
## LETTERS TO ANYONE AND EVERYONE

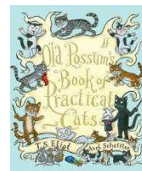
### KID'S KITCHEN by Fiona Bird

Magical, evocative pictures tell the Christmas story of a boy who boards the Polar Express. On arrival at the North Pole he gets a special gift from Santa.

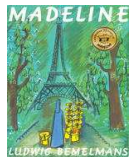
## EXPLORE, DREAM, DISCOVER by Charlotte Samiec
